## MONDAY NIGHT MIXED LEAGUE

A sign-up fee of $\$ 50$ per person is due by April 9, 2018 and will be used for prizes and banquet. You must also have your USGA/GHIN $\$ 37$ fee paid. The first week of play will be April $16^{\text {th }}$ and the final week of the season is August 20st. It will be an 18 week regular season with no play on Memorial Day. The Banquet will be held on September $17^{\text {th }}$. On September $17^{\text {th }}$ we will have a shotgun start of $4: 30$ for the banquet and last day of playoffs.

## League Representative -

The function of the League Representative is to coordinate the needs of the league and other matters related to the league rules. The League Representative can issue rulings with respect to issues that arise concerning these league rules only. If the issue goes outside of these rules or cannot be resolved then a special meeting with the golf committee must be called to resolve the issue.

In match play the decisions concerning rules of golf must be made on the course by the participants at the time of play. Any questions concerning the rules of golf after play can be brought to the pro shop; however the decision cannot be changed after the hole has been completed. Be sure to read the local rules posted in the pro shop before playing. The league representative is not involved in any decisions concerning the rules of golf.

## Rules

1. Play will be governed by the USGA rules of golf plus all local rules.
2. Play is open to both LCC members and non-members which includes full time players and subs.
3. All teams will consist of one man and one woman (age 18 or older).
4. A handicap of $75 \%$ of the difference between the low man and the rest of the players of the match will be used.
5. Individual player's handicaps will be applied by the hole according to the card. The pro shop will prepare cards.
6. The hole is won, lost or tied by using the lowest individual net score for the team vs. the opposing team's lowest individual net score. (Best Ball)
7. Tee times are available from $3: 45$ to $5: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ and are first come, first serve. All players must be on the property before putting your ball in the rack!
8. There are no make-up matches. Subs are allowed and must be the same gender as the person they are subbing for and have a USGA handicap. No subs are allowed in the playoffs.
9. If one member of a team is present and the match tees off the other player may show, but cannot play until the next hole.
10. If no member of a team is in attendance, the opposing team will score by playing against the course. When playing the course the team receives $100 \%$ of their handicap.
11. A putt shall be given ("gimme") within 12 " of the hole, unless the putt is for the win or a halve of the hole.
12. If a player is out of the hole, they are to pick up their ball and their partner's net score will be used in the match.
13. If you pick up you must take the score that you would have most likely made or the "ESC" score, whichever is lower. The ESC chart is presented for ease of reference.

| Handicap | ESC Score |

| $0-9$ | Double Bogey or less |
| $10-19$ | 7 |
| $20-29$ | 8 |
| $30-39$ | 9 |
| 40 | 10 |

14. Club officials will make a decision as to whether or not the course is open for play. Players are responsible for contacting the Pro Shop to confirm if the course is open. If the course is open and play starts, but is then suspended and the course is reopened it shall be the league representative
or his designee who will decide whether or not league play shall resume. If, for any reason, the matches are cancelled then there will be no make-ups. You just simply go to the next match on the schedule. If matches are cancelled during the round prior to the completion of all matches, then the following will apply: If half the matches have been completed, those scores will stand and the incomplete matches will halve the remaining holes to determine the final point total. If less than half the matches have been completed, it is considered a cancellation and you simply go to the next week's match.
15. If a players age and course handicap are greater or equal to 90 , then the player has the option to play from the gold tees for men, and the silver tees for women. Handicaps are in accordance with USGA rule 3-5. Once choosing to play from the gold tees you must play the entire season from the gold tees assuming your handicap + age hasn't dropped below 90 .

## Points

1. Points are scored on a maximum allowed 11 -point system per 9-hole match.
2. Each team will be awarded $1 / 2$ point for each team member (or sub) in attendance.

## Points for the Match

1. When a hole is won outright, the winning team receives 1 point.
2. If a hole is tied, each team receives $1 / 2$ point.
3. When the 9 -hole match is completed, the points earned are added to the attendance points and that constitutes the total match points.
4. Score cards are turned in to the Pro Shop at the end of play each week for the purpose of season standings, posting scores into the computer and handicaps.
